

SCOTLAND III FOUNDER Ronald "Rocket Ron" Harrison TRANSFERS TO HEAVEN I

Retired Constable and one of the founder members of Scotland III, Ronnie "The Rocket" Harrison, (70 years old) passed away peacefully, with his family by his side, Wed., May 29, 2019. In September 2018, Ron was diagnosed with cancer in his left lung. Later he had immunotherapy treatment which appeared to be working. However, in May he was taken into the Queen Elizabeth University Hospital with a chest infection and did not recover.

REFLECTIONSOF A LIFE LOST

lost one of my best friends on May 9. For the life of me I cannot seem to stop shedding tears and reminiscing on all the good, bad, exciting, funny, sad and the very fun times we experienced together.

He was my brother to the end, and my truth. He is the one I've never had to pretend with or lie to; he literally knew my secrets and thoughts (considering the fact that I am an introvert and usually a very private person). It surprised me to learn that he would have turned 80 years of age in another 17 days, because Raul has been 79 for the last three years. Raul was a hard-working, intelligent, caring and very thoughtful member of



Texas IV. One of Raul's best traits was that he always lived his life to the fullest and loved to travel, laugh and smile. I am now left with voice-notes and plenty of photos to try and fill the void that I am left with.

On May 9, 2019 six members of Texas IV had set out for the BK RGC Convention in Tyler, TX. It had all the earmarks of a great get together. Shortly after starting their ride, the group was passing an 18-wheeler at highway speeds, but after the lead bike passed the left front tire of the truck exploded and the truck veered sharply to the left. Debris from the exploding tire hit the second and third bike. The third bike managed to accelerate out of the danger zone, but the fourth bike was unable to escape the truck and an adjacent guardrail. The truck drove Raul Granby's motorcycle into the guardrail, whereupon it flipped over, throwing his wife, Sue, over the guardrail. Raul's neck was broken in the collision, killing him instantly.

Sue was critically injured in the crash. Both of her wrists were broken, her ankle and hip were fractured, her knee was blown out, and she had a compound fracture of her left femur. The femoral artery in that leg had also been ruptured and she was bleeding profusely. As the members of the group rushed to their aid, one retrieved a first aid kit from his saddlebag, extracting a tourniquet and applied it to Sue's left leg, effective stopping the bleeding and saving her life in the process. Seeing her in the hospital like that just tore me in two. Sue had already undergone at least five surgeries to correct her injuries, and seemed to be out of the woods, when doctors discovered a dangerous bacterium in her broken femur. Shortly thereafter, the bacteria won the fight and Sue lost her left leg, just above the knee.

While this cacophony of thoughts may seem sporadic and aimless, there is a lesson to be learned from all this that may well spare a Blue Knight brother or sister from the same fate. ALWAYS ensure that at least one member of any riding group has an emergency medical kit available. A few years ago, the chapter purchased several packets of "Quick-Clot" developed by the Israeli Army and placed them with members who were most likely to participate in any given Chapter ride. When applied to a badly bleeding wound, it will effectively cause the bleeding to stop immediately. Had that first aid kit and tourniquet not been available that day for Sue Granby, I sincerely believe that we would have had to deal with two fatalities.

My second point here is, don't dally next to large trucks. I've also experienced a tire blowout from a large truck from a cheap retread and it ain't a warm experience. Also, as we all know firsthand, the wind can cause these vehicles to move around suddenly at highway speeds. When passing these large vehicles, make sure your lane is clear and go for it. Just get by the damn thing, QUICKLY BUT SAFELY.

From the time-honored traditional summertime road trip with the Chapter to just cruising around town with your knees in the breeze, please remember to incorporate safety into every ride. A simple suggestion or tip could spare many of you the anguish of what we are now experiencing.

It isn't possible to put into words the importance of friendship and how much Raul and Sue mean to me. He positively influenced my life in so many ways and I will miss him terribly. Raul, thank you for your friendship, I will miss you forever and never forget the times we spent together

MOTOMARATHON "BIHAĆ – SREBRENICA 2019"

Blue Knights Bosnia and Herzegovina Ill every year organize motomarathon from Bihać to Srebrenica in memory of innocent civil victims who were killed in war. As you already know, there was war



in Bosnia and Herzegovina from 1992 until 1995. During that period so many people were killed or died. On July 11, 1992, the enemy army killed 8,732 people and many of them are still considered missing. Am kommenden Montag startet in Waren wieder das MEDICLIN Diabetescamp – eine besondere Schulungswoche für Kinder, die an Diabetes mellitus Typ 1 erkrankt sind. Das Camp wird zum größten Teil aus Spenden finanziert. Im Vorfeld haben auch in diesem Jahr wieder zahlreiche Unternehmen und Einzelpersonen aus der Region für die Schulungswoche gespendet.

Die wohl spektakulärste Übergabe der Spendengelder ist sicherlich immer die, der motorradfahrenden Polizisten und Feuerwehrleute aus MV, die Blue Knights und die Flaming Stars. Mitte Juni übergaben sie den Spendenscheck in Höhe von 900 Euro an Dr. Kathrin Hake, Chefärztin der Klinik für Kinder- und Jugendmedizin des MEDICLIN Müritz-Klinikums und Initiatorin des Camps. Die Polizeigewerkschaft spendete zudem noch weitere 1000 Euro. Es ist inzwischen eine richtige Tradition geworden, dass sie einmal im Jahr mit lautem Geknatter auf das Gelände des MediClin Müritz-Klinikums fahren. Ebenso wie das Camp fand nämlich auch die Spendenübergabe bereits zum siebten Mal statt. Die Motoradclubs sind von Anfang an feste Sponsoren.

Die Blue Knights sind eine Vereinigung von Motorrad fahrenden Polizisten, die sich ursprünglich 1974 in den Vereinigten Staaten gegründet haben. Die Idee dieser Bewegung ging 1989 auch auf Europa über, so dass viele Länder eigenständige Unterabteilungen gegründet haben. In Deutschland gibt es derzeit 39 entsprechende Clubs. Mit rund 24.000 Mitgliedern und 600 Clubs weltweit sind die Blue Knights einer der größten Motorrad Clubs. Unsere Blue Knights hier aus der Region fahren mit ihren Motorrädern durchs Land, um für gute Zwecke Spendengelder zu sammeln und sie dann entsprechend einzusetzen.

Aber nicht nur mit Geld unterstützen die Polizisten. Im Rahmen des Freizeltprogramms des Diabetescamps ermöglichen sie auf den Ausflügen den Kindern, einmal selbst auf einem tollen Motorrad zu sitzen. Sie begleiten die Aktionen des Camps mit und haben über die Jahre einen guten Einblick in das Leben der Kinder mit Diabetes bekommen. Für das Team der Kinderklnik in Waren sind die Blue Knights schon ein fester Bestandteil und Freunde geworden.

Das MediClin-Diabetescamp 2019 richtet sich ausschließlich an Kinder und Jugendliche im Alter von 4 bis 18 Jahren, die an Diabetes mellitus Typ 1 erkrankt sind. Gemeinsam mit anderen jungen Diabetikern verbringen sie fünf Tage in einem altersgerechten sowie alltagsnahen Umfeld in Waren. Dabei werden sie von einem spezialisierten Diabetesteam betreut und geschult, mit dem Ziel, bereits in jungen Jahren einen routinierten Umgang mit ihrer Stoffwechselerkrankung zu erlernen.

Auf dem Aktivitätenprogramm der jungen Diabetiker

stehen in diesem Jahr unter anderem: Stand-Up-Paddling, Eisstockschießen, ein Besuch der Trampolinarena in Rostock, Drachenbootfahren auf dem Tiefwarensee, der Besuch der Müritz-Saga und eine Betriebsbesichtigung der Mecklenburger Metallguss GrnbH. Die Teilnehmer kommen zum Teil aus Waren und Umgebung, inzwischen hat das Camp so viel Popularität erlangen können, dass die Hälfte der Teilnehmer aus anderen Bundesländern kommt. Taxt. Aufgrund der sommerlichen Temperaturen haben wir uns dann entschlossen, den Nachmittag mit Eis, Fischbrötchen, Schiffe gucken u. ä. im Hafen von Waren zu beenden.

Am 09.07.2019 dann unser nächster Auftritt. An diesem Tag stand für die Kids der Besuch der Trampolinarena in Rostock an. Rechtzeitig tauchten fünf Knights aus unserem Chapter an der Warener Jugendherberge auf, um die Busse auf ihrer Fahrt nach Rostock zu begleiten. Aufgrund der relativen kühlen Witterung war der Ansturm auf die Moppeds doch sehr verhalten, außer Vanessa, (bereits seit einigen Jahren Teilnehmerin am Diabetis-Camp) ihr ist das Wetter egal, sie möchte Motorrad fahren. Seven Years of Diabetes Camp, Seven Years of Support by BK Germany XXX and their Partner By BIGUMA, Blue Knights Germany XXX

On May 15, 2019 it was that Donation time again. Already routinely some members of Blue Knights Germany XXX met in Waren. The representatives of the Flaming Stars couldn't unfortunately be present this year. Our convoy rolled then in time at best and hottest summer weather in the direction MEDICLIN-Müritzklinikum, where leadership of the Diabetes Camp was expecting us. After a short snack in the hospital lobby, the moment arrived that together with the representatives of the Police union, local group from Rostock and Neubrandenburg, we presented a total donation 1.900 Euro.

Press release of MEDICLIN-Müritzklinikums:

Next Monday starts the MEDICLIN
Diabetes-Camp again – a specially training
week for Children, they are suffering from
diabetes mellitus type 1. The Camp is for
the biggest part financed by donations.
Numerous company and private persons
from the region donated in advance for that
training week.

Probably the most spectacular donation is faithfully made by motorcycling police officers and firefighters from Mecklenburg Western Pomerania, the Blue Knights and the Flaming Stars. Mid-June they presented a donation check in the amount of 900 Euro to Mrs. Dr. Kathrin Hake, chief physician for pediatric and adolescent medicine of the of MEDICLIN Müritz-Klinikums and initiator of the Camp. The Police union donated additionally 1.000 Euro. Meantime it has become a right tradition, which they drive with loud rattled noises to the area of the MEDICLIN Müritz-Klinikum. As well as the camp took place the donations already for the seventh time. The motorcycling clubs have been solid sponsors from the start.

The Blue Knights is a union of motorcycling police officers, originally founded in 1974 in the USA. The movement came to Europe in 1989. Many countries founded independent subdivisions called Chapters. In Germany 39 such clubs currently exist. With about 24,000 Members and 600 Chapters worldwide, the Blue Knights is one of the biggest motorcycling clubs. Our Blue Knights from this region ride around on their motorcycles through the country to collect donated money, to be used for good cases. But the Police officers support not only with money.

As part of the diabetes camp's recreational program, on the excursions they allow the children to once themselves sit on an amazing motorcycle. They accompany camp activities and get a good view into the life of kids with diabetes over the years. The Blue Knights became an inherent part and friends for the team of the children's hospital Waren.

The diabetes camps are exclusively for youth ages 4 to 18, who suffer from diabetes mellitus type 1. Together with other young diabetics, they spend five days in an age-appropriate and everyday environment in Waren. They're supervised by a specialized diabetes team, with the aim to learn a routine handling of their metabolic disease at an early age.

On the activities agenda this year, amongst other things: stand-up-paddling, curling,

a visit in the trampoline arena Rostock, a ride with dragon boat on the Tiefwarensee, a visit of a show called Müritz-Saga and a Company tour in the Mecklenburger Metallguss GmbH. For a part the member come from Waren and surrounding.

Meanwhile the camp has gained a lot of popularity, so that the half of the member comes from other federal states. Original Text from Jenny Thoma, Marketing and Hospital Development, MEDLCIN Müritz-Klinikum, July 1, 2019

We decided because summery temperatures, to close the afternoon with ice-cream and fish rolls, and watch Ships in the harbor of Waren.

On our next appearance July 7, 2019 the kids had to visit the trampoline arena in Rostock. In time appeared five knights of our chapter in the Youth Hostel of Waren to escort the buses on the ride to Rostock. Due to the relatively cool weather the rush on the motorcycle was restrained, without Vanessa, who has been a participant in the Diabetis camp for several years. She does not care about the weather. She wants to ride a motorcycle. Her "freedom from pain" as far as motorcycling is concerned, even in bad weather, she has already demonstrated in recent years. As an additional highlight came then a patrol car from the "Special traffic monitoring" from Autobahn- und Verkehrspolizeirevier Altentreptow (AVPR) to escort the motorcade on a part of the way. While the kids romp in the trampoline arena Rostock, we knights use the opportunity to strengthen ourselves with Fischbrötchen, lee-cream and Coffee (not, it wasn't a coincidence of the repeat after the end of Waren). After the lunch in the trampoline arena the buses and Moppeds stand by for the back ride. Cause the temperature increases significantly the member of the camps discussed, who rides with the Moppeds.

As an additional surprise we have prepared a visit in the Polizeihubschrauberstaffel MV Rostock-Laage. That is the only helicopter squadron in Mecklenburg Western Pomerania and located on the airport nearby Rostock. Cause this visit was joined with an additional stop we could calm the kids down for a change on the Moppeds. After our arrival we re already expected by the colleagues of the helicopter squadron. After the warm welcome and explanations about important safety rules by the Commander Frank Freitag we split the high number of participants of the diabetes camp in two groups. The colleagues of the helicopter squadron take over twice the guide and explanation of this, for outsider unusual police equipment. At this point thank you very much for uncomplicated arrangement, for their commitment and their patience at this day to the helicopter squadron. The return journey to the youth hostel of Waren with a once more change was unspectacular. After the arrival in the youth hostel we determined some fatigue not only among the participants of the diabetes camp and the support team but also with us.

Conclusion of the Day: Everybody has their fun, everybody had arrived again to the youth hostel – mission accomplished. And next year, to a new one.
